The INA Nanny Basic Skills Assessment was developed to assess a nanny's basic child care knowledge. The INA Nanny Credential Exam has 100 multiple choice questions and 1 open response essay question with multiple parts. The exam is a timed exam that is available to be taken online. The exam is designed to test a nanny's practical knowledge of child care. A proctor must be secured by the exam candidate to administer the INA Nanny Credential Exam prior to testing.

The International Nanny Association Credential Exam and Basic Skills Assessment do not enable visas to the USA or other countries.

The International Nanny Association (INA) wishes to denounce the misuse of the INA Basic Skills Assessment and Nanny Credential Exam. The INA retains the sole right to control and distribute these tests for the purpose of basic childcare assessment of knowledge.

The INA gives no authority for a member agency to utilize this exam or assessment without permission and makes no promises that passing the exam or assessment will insure visas to the USA or any other country. Agencies advertising that they are licensed to run these tests in order to offer visas to the US or other countries thereby giving false hopes to participants will be reported to the proper legal authorities.

Passing of the Basic Skills Assessment or Nanny Credential Exam does not automatically give the test taker membership in the INA nor does it ensure the candidate is an adequate caregiver. It merely assesses the childcare knowledge of the test taker.
